### Record of Decision made in respect of the Mayor's Police and Crime Commissioner functions

<b>Title/subject:</b> Violence Against Women and Girls – Pilot Interventions
<b>Serial No:</b> MPCC212
<b>Summary:</b> To allocate funding from the Violence Reduction Unit that will support suitably qualified and experienced organisations to develop and pilot suitable interventions which can be delivered against the VRU VAWG workstream. As the original Expression of Interest (EOI) process did not attract any submissions for delivery in Calderdale, there is also a proposal to follow a further EOI process specifically with that place with £30,000 available.
<b>Requested Decisions:</b>  The recommendation is to agree the funding allocations to 6 voluntary and community organisations totalling £145,138 and well a further £30,000 specifically for Calderdale.

<b>Decision:</b> Agree allocation of funding to West Yorkshire's five districts during 2022/23 to the total value of £175,138.
